## March 10, 2019 Why I am here? Continued]

'Why am I here?' is a question of purpose and it triggers the reason for your existence.

Luke 4:14, Luke 4:16-22

Jesus read from the Scripture why He came, and we saw that all eyes were fastened on Him immediately (Luke 4:20)

By the reason of discovering myself and paying attention to the details of what I came here on earth to do, I can be so sure of a positive outcome for my life.

- 1. Purpose is the definition of life, it defines the reason why you are here. Jesus discovered why Purpose is the comprehensive plan of God for my life, the A-z of His assignment for you. Nothing was created for entertainment
- 2. Everything exists with a clear purpose in view, there is a reason you came. You need to have a clear view of why you are here. Purpose is a comprehensive plan of God for you. Vision is the unveiling of that plan. Vision, therefore is the revelation of purpose/future. What you are to be by the reason of purpose is called destiny. Destiny is not in view if purpose isn't known. You can't talk about success when purpose is yet to be identified. Everything about us is tied to purpose.
- 3. Therefore, I was born with a purpose and for a purpose (meaning you were born with an assignment). You can't afford to copy anyone else, no one can be your measuring standard. Even identical twins don't have the same destiny. The fact is this, you don't need to be like anyone else, and that's enough to get you excited! In the course of destiny, you could have partnerships, but you have an assignment only you can get done.
- 4. Why am I here? It's encountered by a discovery, meaning there must be a search sponsored by a desire. Purpose births existence not the other way around. Keep asking, Lord why am I here? Pay attention to your passion, drives and abilities; pay attention to what gets you infuriated. One way or the other, you would find defining lines towards what God has in mind for you to do. There are so many things God has placed within you, only your system gets excited about it. You came with a purpose and for a purpose, all you need is already within you. Matt 13:44. Every purpose is like a treasure field. Matt 13:45-46. The question should be, why am I here? It's possible you aren't being respected because you don't yet know who you are. Purposes don't change, but plans may change; however, plans may intercept purpose, you may take a wrong steps on the wrong path that may terminate the fulfilment of that purpose ultimately.
- 5. Therefore, God isn't solely responsible for my Success: Everybody has a responsibility over his or her destiny, learn to act on the nudging you are having. Work out your destiny with God on your side, God is more interested in your doing well than you would ever be; remember, it's all for His Name's Sake. His Brand is on you. For instance, when you consider electronic devices,

the final thing placed on a device is a brand; it helps us identify the Manufacturer. God placed His brand on us as the first thing; He desires that we do well in life because He does not want to have products in the market that are not successful. Have the **Influence Mindset**; only you can do what God has called you to do- no one else can! Your uniqueness lies in the discovery of purpose; God isn't responsible for either your success or failure; it's all on you!

## INFLUENCE WISDOM THOUGHTS

- 1. **Life must be lived with a purpose and for a purpose.** (I must live my life with a purpose and for a purpose.
- 2. **It must be sourced from God: God is the Source of all purposes** Every genuine purpose has its root in God. Ps 68:26 (NLT); Rom 11:36 (TPT); James 1:17 (KJV, BBE, T4T). It cannot be sourced from men's opinions or feelings.
- 3. Purpose must be selfless; it's for a people and a generation: *Make your life God-interest, service-oriented and people-driven.* Luke 4:18-19. Everything about purpose is selfless, it has nothing to do with family or popularity; It has got everything to do with people- Luke 4:20.
  - What can I do for a generation? That should be your question! How can you be living on this earth without sense? You have been sent to a generation, not to your family. Everyone that made sense in the past generation and this generation were people who had answers to a question for a generation. Think people; be people-driven. God won't put more on you than you can bear.
- 4. Purpose must be stated, it must be clearly spelt out without assumptions. If purpose is not clearly stated, it can't be defined/measure/attained/actualized/accomplished. Heb. 10:7 (KJV, MSG, T4T). You are here to do what He wants you to do. Luke 4:17 (KJV) Habk. 2:2 (KJV) Jesus said, "T must finish the work of Him that sent me. He could only say that because the purpose of His coming was previously defined. John 9; 4; John 17:4 (KJV).

With all these in mind, take note of these 5 things:

- a. The discovery of your purpose defines the finishing line and the boundary of your existence.
- b. It gives direction and births focus: Phil 3:13
- c. It puts you on the run consistently: Habk. 2:2
- d. It helps you to know whether you are making progress and possibly if you are still in line- Act 26:22,23 Phil 3:13,14 2 Tim 4:6,7
- e. When your purpose is clearly stated, Heaven, hell and people are watching: Luke 4:20-29, 33-35, 36-37 (KJV) Vision must be accomplished, the reason you came, mustn't be aborted.
